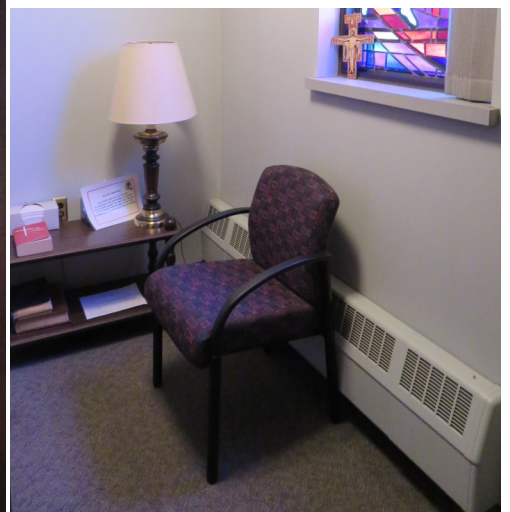

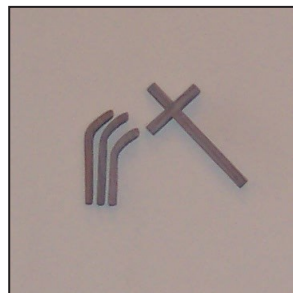

The traditional number of Stations of the Cross is fourteen stations. However, in some booklets, a fifteenth station is added – the resurrection. Why? Perhaps to end the stations in a positive light. What is important to remember is that there are no rubrics which define how many stations there are/can be. It is becoming even more common to add a “0th station” which is the Agony in the Garden. Please remember, whatever the number of stations, our purpose in praying them is to remember the saving work of Jesus Christ.

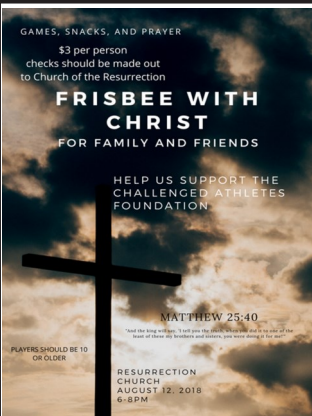
Holiday Bazaar 2018 -

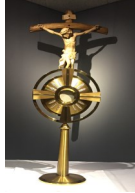

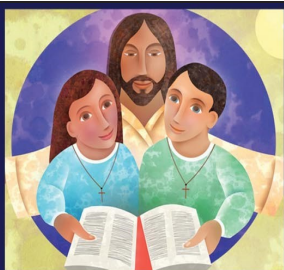

There is no age requirement like during the regular season.

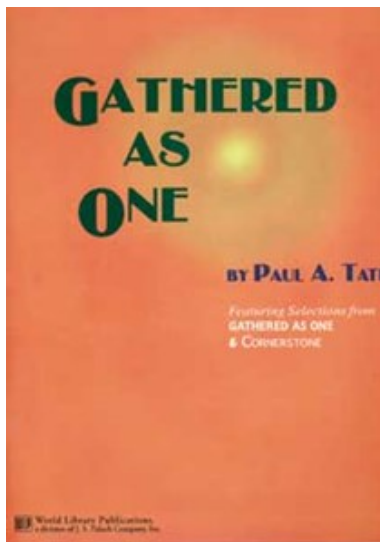
There is no rehearsal prior to the Mass, except for the accompanist and the cantor.
