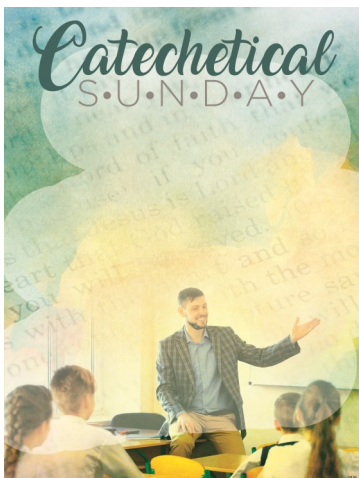

# Weekly Words from The Rock

We continue to do our study into the Ten Commandments.

There is much more to the commandments than meets the eye. My work comes from Father Peter Klein's Catholic Source Book, Copyright 2000, pages 82-89.

Last week, we looked at the Second, Third and Fourth Commandment so now we move to the Fifth and Sixth Commandments.

The Fifth Commandment reads, "You shall not kill."

What are the requirements of the Fifth Commandment?

- Respect for Human Life
- Respect for the dignity of persons
- Safeguarding peace

What are the major sins against the Fifth Commandment?

- Intentional Homicide
- Abortion
- Euthanasia (mercy killing, assisted suicide)
- Suicide

The Fifth Commandment also forbids other sins:

- Scandal
- Bigotry and Hatred
- Physical or emotional abuse
- Violence of any kind against another person
- Inattention to one's health
- Abuse of alcohol or drugs

The Fifth Commandment provides strict conditions for legitimate defense by military force.

- The damage brought on the nation or world by the aggressor must be lasting, grave, and certain.
- All other efforts at resolution have been tried and failed or even impractical.
- There must be well-founded hope of success.

- The use of arms must not cause worse disorder than the evil to be stopped (a condition requiring more serious consideration than even because of the power of modern means of destruction)

The Sixth Commandment reads, "Thou shall not commit adultery."

What are the three forms of chastity?

- The chastity of spouses
- The chastity of widows
- The chastity of virgins

What fruits are found amongst the engaged who live chastity?

- A discovery of mutual respect
- An apprenticeship in fidelity
- The hope of receiving one another from God

What are the sins against chastity?

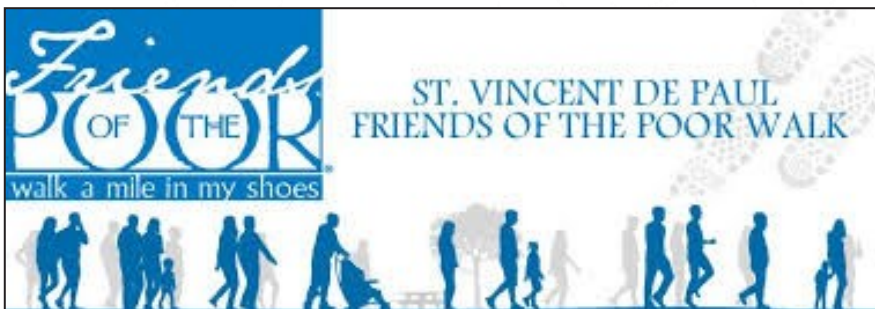
- Lust (disordered desire for, inordinate enjoyment of sexual pleasure)
- Masturbation (self-stimulation for sexual pleasure)
- Fornication (carnal union between unmarried)
- Pornography (real or simulated sex photographed or filmed for display to third parties)
- Rape (forcible violation of the sexual intimacy of another person)
- Prostitution (sex for pay)
- Homosexual activity (sexual relations between two persons of the same sex)

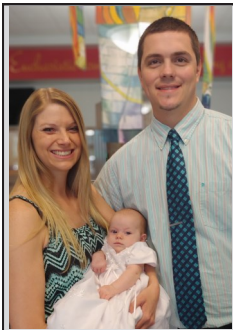
