*****DISCOVER** the background, depth, and relevance of the Liturgy of the Word at Sunday Mass through a weekly discussion of the readings for the upcoming Sunday's Mass. This is an opportunity to unpack the readings with fellow parishioners, and with online commentary by scripture scholar Brant Pitre. **SUNDAY SCRIPTURE STUDY** will be held on Wednesdays from September 18th through May 20th.



*****IMAGINE** an evening one Wednesday a month when Catholic women accompany one another in reading classics, great books and timeless spiritual works from Western and Christian traditions in order to nurture their hearts and moral imagination. This can happen when participating in **WELL READ MOMS**. (For all women, not just Moms). Weekly attendance is not required.



*****ENCOUNTER ROMANS: THE GOSPEL OF SALVATION** which has been at the center of controversy, conversion, and reflection since the day it was written. This 8 session study explains the Catholic teaching on salvation, what is required--faith or works, and highlights connections Paul makes with Jesus and the Old Testament. Offered on consecutive Tuesday mornings from October 22nd through December 10th.
