- 5. New Trustee: Cathy is stepping down. Thank you, Cathy, for your services! Paul Drucker will be moving into the place as senior trustee and Dianne Plager will be moving into the position of junior trustee
- 6. Managing the Christmas Masses
 - a. Father possibly looking at doing 4 Masses.
 - b. Using available space for reservations (Father Zenk South and Center Hall and Cry Room). Gathering Space available solely for walk-in and check-in ministries.
 - c. Not sure on Masses times yet
 - d. Will probably not have walk-in option at all the Masses
 - e. Will still use East doors for live streaming of Mass attendants to receive Communion
 - f. Additional Parking will be available at Mayo High School
 - g. Concern with Christmas falling on a Friday and the number of volunteers needed to run all the Masses both Christmas, the weekend of December 26-27, and January 1st (a Holy Day of Obligation)
- 7. Regina had seen a non-touch holy water dispenser, will track down more information on it and give to Erica
