LETTER TO THE BISHOP

You are free to respond to God's call to live the faith—to worship, witness, and serve as a confirmed Catholic. If you wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, write a letter of request to the Bishop stating your desire. Please follow these guidelines for your letter.

GREETING

Begin your letter with a greeting: Dear Bishop Barron,

LETTER BODY

- 1. Introduce yourself by sharing something about your family or your background. You don't need to get super personal or detailed.
- 2. Explain how you have prepared for the sacrament. It is important to share specific parts of preparation that increased your understanding of the faith and/or how you now feel called to serve God's church.
- 3. Describe one or more ways you have encountered Jesus during your formation process and how that impacted you.
- 4. Share what gifts of the Holy Spirit you might have and explain why or share what gift you hope you see strengthened and why.
- 5. Finally, Request the sacrament. Include some reasons why you would like to be Confirmed.

CONCLUSION & FORMATTING

Conclude the letter and include your full handwritten signature.

- Keep your letter to ONE PAGE.
- Typed using 12 point font
- Do not fold the letter
- Due March 1 of Year II
- Print using white paper or white stationery.
 - the parish can assist with printing

The Bishop requires a letter from each individual requesting Confirmation: He and the Youth Ministry Director will both read your letters. Please give this your full effort.
